Hayfield Heroes



This week we have been finalising our awards systems and I am very pleased to announce our very first Hayfield Hero award was presented today to Hermione in Year 2.

More details will be shared soon but the rewards for Reception and Key Stage 1 will be:

- **Hero Points:** Children will be awarded these for exceeding expectations in their learning, effort and behaviour. When they collect 25 hero points they will have achieved Hero Level 1 and receive a certificate and sticker. (Level 2 is 50 points and Level 3 is 100 points which they collect through the year)
- **Hayfield Heroes:** These are recorded in our special Hayfield Hero book and will be awarded each week by their teachers to one child per class who has excelled all week.

We would also like to celebrate what the children do out of school activities so if they receive any awards or achievements in clubs and activities they take part in please send them in on Friday and we will award them in assembly.

As our numbers grow, more awards will be added which we have already planned. We will also be looking forward to when we have enough children for a full Celebration Assembly which will be held on a Friday and parents will be invited to join us and see the children receive their awards. Our behaviour policy and system will also be shared soon which is in all the classes and we have shared with the children.

I can also announce that our class names have now been decided! In the infants (R,1&2) the classes will all be named after hayfield creatures. In Key Stage 2 they will be numbered as the children will be older and more grown up then. Year 1/2 children have decided that their name will be Squirrel Class and our Reception Class will now be called Bumblebee Class.

When you visit next you will see that our school is becoming much more colourful thanks to our Site Supervisor Mr Hobbs who is now working on our painting programme throughout the school. The classrooms all have an accent the same as their cupboards and in the corridor there is a flash of colour to match. Soon we will start work on our group rooms and look forward to revealing them in the future.

Our reading scheme is going to be delivered tomorrow so the children will be bringing home reading books soon!

Thank you for helping us spread the word about our school. We have already filled our tour slots for prospective parents for Reception 2016 and are now adding more! We have also several enquiries about parents looking to move to us now and I am pleased to share we are expecting another 3 children into Year R,1&2 soon and another Year 2 child is in the process of applying. There are some more who we are showing around so hopefully our numbers will continue to grow.
