Parent Feedback



This week we sent home the feedback from our parent questionnaires we sent out in January. We were really pleased with the overwhelmingly positive feedback that we received and also with the feedback and suggestions with things we can work to improve on. Thank you all for completing them, here are some of the highlights of what you think of our school:

"The learning environment is exciting, stimulating and engages children. The different rooms/areas of the school enable children to think creatively and motivates them to work to their full potential. Also the reward system are a fantastic way of motivating and rewarding pupils. My daughter is always so proud of herself and her achievements when her hard work/effort is rewarded and recognised."

"The staff, the ethos, the Christian values which are genuinely in play at the school and very evident. The sheer amount of work and dedication put into the school/its pupils."

"Lots of different ways of learning to cover all children's different needs and always have excited things/events going on. [The Teacher and TA] have really helped [our daughter] come on in all areas."

"Creativity and positivity, promoting good attitudes and good behaviours is something this school does very well."
