HOMEWORK

STATUTORY ASSESSMENTS

SATs will be completed between 13th - 16th May 2024. They will be assessed in grammar, spelling, reading, arithmetic and reasoning. The tests help measure the progress pupils have made and identify if they need additional support in a certain area. The tests are also used to assess schools' performance and to produce national performance data.

Children will be prepared by completing regular assessments during Autumn and Spring terms, and working through SATs style questions.

As SATs approach, the children will practise past SATs papers, so we would ask that you please not complete these at home as practise or with tutors, as it can provide false data.
