
NEW SENSORY ROOM AT HAYFIELD CROSS

- Promoting mental and physical relaxation
- Reducing stress
- · Improving co-ordination and motor development
- Promoting cognitive development by increased brain function
- Providing security
- In creasing calmness

Visiting the sensory room for a short while allows our pupils to ready themselves for the day ahead, or take a moment to reduce stress or anxiety levels during the school day.

Revealing the knowledge of your glory in the face of Jesus Christ,


Your Son, our Lord,
