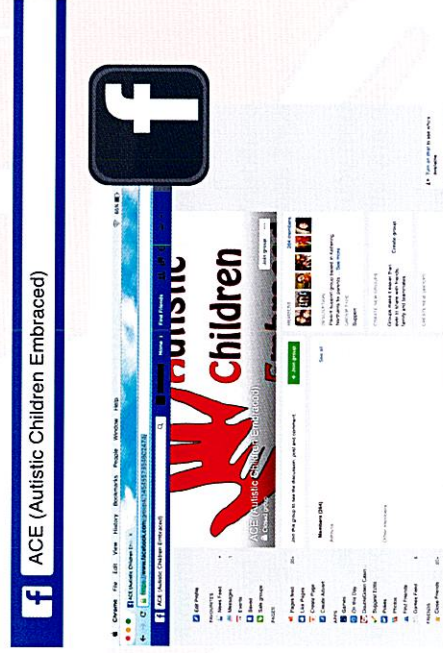

Objectives And Aims Of The Group:

- To support each other by sharing information and ideas.
- To empower parents of children/young adults on the Autistic Spectrum, thus promoting positive thoughts and outcomes.
- For everyone to leave the group with a positive outlook by drawing on each others personal experiences and strengths.

We organize talks, visitors, discussions and presentation evenings. At each meeting we finish with tea and coffee, which gives everyone a chance to meet and talk to others with similar experiences. We also have a "sale" table where you can buy items to help your child (like self tying shoe laces). We run a "Lending Library" where you can borrow books and DVD's each month for a small charge. We have a leaflet table & information board.

At each meeting we offer parent/carers to have a private 1-1 session with the Autism Outreach Team.
