Homework Project Ideas

We expect all children to read everyday. In addition to learning spellings and maths you may also wish to enrich their theme learning with other experiences. Here are some ideas of things you could do:

- Create a travel brochure of a country / town you have been to or would like to visit
- Create a piece of art work that is traditional to a country
- Investigate and create food from another country and bring it in for us to try
- Create a 3D model of a mode of transport for us to travel the world (hot air balloons, flying train, flying carpet, teleporters)
- If you have any friends or family from another country, can they send you a letter / picture/ postcard/ from their country to show us?

Please feel free to explore your own ideas and your child's interests. This can be shown through research, using the internet (safely!), making books, posters, information leaflets, models etc. Visits to places related to the topic can also be brilliant ways to inspire learning, especially if they gather information, pictures and artefacts and share them back in class.

This homework is optional so you can do as little or as much as you like and there is no deadline so you can do pieces throughout the term and bring it in.

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- You are an explorer and have discovered a brand new place in the world. Can you create resources to tell people about it? This could be travel brochure, leaflet, publicity, non chronological report, fact files of new animals etc.
- Write a story set in a country of your choice – you can read it to the class when it is finished.
- Create a traditional ceremonial African mask
- Can you create a treasure co-ordinate map and write directions on how to find your treasure?
- Using any media (art, PPT, oral) create something to present to the class about Fairtrade. It could be a leaflet, poster, or presentation.

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
